The minutes of the 2nd Governing Body Meeting held on 29.11.2024 were confirmed unanimously.

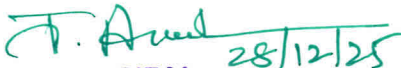
Agenda Item 3: Review of Action Taken on the 2nd Governing Body Meeting (29.11.2024)
